After successful completion of assessments students will be provided with a Statement of Attainment. This Statement of Attainment is the training pre-requisite for Main Roads Western Australia's accreditation in Worksite Traffic Management. A plastic wallet size photo ID Card with workzone accreditation is also provided.

Course overview

This unit covers the completion of the preparation and documentation of work zone traffic management plans. It includes the planning for the preparation, undertaking of the preparation, finalisation of the preparation processes and supporting the application of the preparation. This unit requires the identification of plan inputs, production of calculations, drawings, plan options and solutions and specifications required for the implementation of work zone traffic management plan, it does not include the certification of the plan.

Dress

A minimum standard of Company Personnel Protective Equipment (PPE) and fully enclosed footwear is required.

Pre course Preparation

CPCCOHS1001A 'Work safely in the construction industry' (Work Safe WA Blue / White card) required.

It is strongly recommended that all Students have the following before attempting this course:

- Experience in traffic management or experience in road construction or maintenance,
- BCCCM3003C Implement Traffic Management Plan,
- BCCCM2013C Control Traffic with a Stop Slow Bat,
- Current Drivers Licence, and
- Computer word processing skills.

Key Topics

- Plan for the preparation of workzone traffic management plans,
- Undertake the workzone management plan preparation,
- Finalise preparation processes of workzone traffic management plan, and
- Support and review the application of workzone traffic management plan.



Assessments

All students will be required to read Traffic Management Plans (TMP) and Traffic Control Diagrams (TCD) including completing written activities throughout the three day training session.

On completion of this practical and theory workshop students need to provide further work-based evidence in the form of Two (2) Traffic Management Plans as per scenarios provided on the course, (One Non Complex) (One Complex)

Students will be **given three months to submit** TMP work based evidence. Extensions of one month will only be granted under exceptional circumstances at the discretion of Earthworks Training and Assessment Services. Original assignments to be submitted in Hard copy. Students shall retain a copy of what was submitted as originals will be archived and not returned.
