After successful completion of assessments the participant will be provided with a Statement of Attainment. This can be produced to any MVR office to be issued with a personalized ID Card for a cost of \$26.40 which is valid for a period of three years.

Course overview

Worksite traffic management is the management of traffic movement through or past a works area with a maximum of safety and a minimum of inconvenience for both the road workers and the road user. Good management is achieved through use of standardised methods, procedures and physical layouts for routine works situations and the adaptation of these standardised methods to more complex situations.

Dress

A minimum standard of Company Personnel Protective Equipment (PPE) and clothing fully enclosed footwear is required.

Pre course Preparation

It is strongly recommended that all Students have the following before attempting this course:

- Experience in traffic management or experience in road construction or maintenance
- BCCCM3003C Implement Traffic Management Plan (WZ3)
- BCCCM2013 Control Traffic with a Stop Slow Bat (WZ2)
- Current Drivers Licence
- Basic computer word processing skills



Key Topics

- Plan for the preparation of Workzone traffic management plans
- Undertake the workzone management plan preparation
- Finalise preparation processes of workzone traffic management plan
- Support and review the application of workzone traffic management plan

Assessments

All students will be required to read Traffic Management Plans (TMP) and Traffic Control Diagrams (TCD) including completing written activities throughout the three day training session.

On completion of this practical and theory workshop students need to provide further work-based evidence in the form of Two (2) Traffic Management Plans as per scenarios provided on the course, (Non Complex and Complex)

Students will be **given three (3) months to submit** TMP work based evidence. Extensions of one month will only be granted under exceptional circumstances at the discretion of Earthworks Training and Assessment Services. Original assignments to be submitted in Hard copy. Students shall retain a copy of what was submitted as originals will be archived and not returned.
