

# REFRESHER /CONVERSION COURSE WZ4 — RIICRM201E ESCORT MOBILE WORKS

- Course:** Refresher WZ4 - (half day) - full day

After successful completion of the theory and practical activities students will be provided with a Certificate of Refreshment / Conversion. This can be produced to the Motor Vehicle Registry (MVR) office for issue of a personalized ID Card which costs \$30 for certification. Northern Territory certification is valid for three years from the date of issue.

This course is a requirement on all NT Government Specifications and Contracts for works within NT Government controlled road reserves, throughout the NT.

All participant will need to have good writing, self management and numeracy skills to complete this learning program -

### Assessments

Participants may be required to read and interpret some Austroads Temporary Traffic Management Guides (Part 1-10) and participate in Safe Work Method Statement (SWMS) including traffic management procedure for high risk works. This includes completing written activities throughout the training session. On completion of the theory component participants will be required to complete a written test.
