Course Length: 1 Day or 2 Days pending accreditation held

Accreditation: **WZ2/TC** - Control Traffic with a Stop-Slow Bat and **WZ3/TMI** - Implement Traffic Management Plans
After successful completion of the bridging course participants will be provided with a Certificate of Refreshment Training. This can be produced to any Motor Vehicle Registry (MVR) office to be issued with a personalized ID Card for a cost of \$30 which is currently valid for a period of three years.

Course overview

This course is mandatory requirement on all Government controlled road reserves, throughout NT. This course will update participants theory and practical skills required to implement traffic management plans or control traffic for works on roads, parking areas and restricted access construction sites, ensuring traffic flow is maintained and risk to the safety of the public and workers is minimised. *You cannot commence work in Northern Territory until you have completed the Conversion course and obtained your MVR cards.*

Dress

A minimum standard of PCBU / Employer - Personnel Protective Equipment (PPE) and clothing consisting of fully enclosed footwear is required.

Pre course Preparation

All Participants **MUST** bring with them to the course:

- General Construction Induction Training card (NT White Card or interstate equivalent).
- Australian motor vehicle driver's licence
- Original Statement of Attainment/s for Unit of Competency,
 - ◇ RIIWHS205D - Control Traffic with a Stop Slow Bat,
 - ◇ RIIWHS302D - Implement Traffic Management Plan, and
- Current equivalent Interstate Road Authority cards - (WZ2/TC and WZ3/TMI Required to work on DIPL roads).



Specific Criteria - Evidence Required

1. Participants must provide evidence of working in Temporary Traffic Management (TTM) roles within the past 12 months.
2. Participants must ensure interstate accreditation has not expired more than three (3) months otherwise they shall be required to undertake the full course again.
